## Successor fund transfer to Retirement Portfolio Service superannuation fund

## What has changed?

In December 2017, ANZ announced that it sold the OnePath Life Limited insurance business to Zurich Insurance Group AG (Zurich). As a result of the sale, the Wealth division of ANZ needs to separate and transition the insurance business to Zurich.

As part of this separation, on 13 April 2019, OnePath Custodians Pty Limited (ABN 12 008 508 496, RSE L0000673) transferred the members and assets of the OnePath MasterFund (ABN 53 789 980 697, RSE R1001525) to the Retirement Portfolio Service (**RPS**) superannuation fund (ABN 61 808 189 263, RSE R1000986).

Grow Wrap superannuation and pension products are offered through the RPS superannuation which is the receiving fund of the assets and members of the OnePath MasterFund.
